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

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



The patient was conscious and coherent, abrasion on lips, possible dislocation on left wrist, laceration on right knee. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDY Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Purok 1, Guibang, Gamu, Isabela last **April 10, 2024**. The patient was abrasion on the left foot and tooth knock out. Driving under influence of liquor as verbalized by the patient. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDY Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Circumferential Road, Brgy. Guinatan, City of Ilagan, Isabela last **April 17, 2024**. The patient was suffered abrasions on the right eyebrow, both knees and hands. Driving under influence of liquor as verbalized by the patient. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to City of Ilagan Medical Center for proper disposition.




