The patient suffered multiple abrasion on upper extremities, avulsion on left knuckle. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDY Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** Infront of Talosig Store, Brgy. Baligatan, City of Ilagan, Isabela last **August 21, 2023**. The patient was conscious, possible head injury. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient WAS brought to GFNDy Sr. Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Medical Incident** at Purok 6. Bugallon Proper Ramon, Isabela sa last **August 22, 2023**. The patient was conscious and body weakness, pale looking. Accordingly, she suffered pain on lower abdomen with pain scale 7-10. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was brought to Cagayan Valley Medical Center for check-up (vice versa).



PDRRMO/DART 831 provided transport of patient to the patient diagnosed breast cancer stage 4. The patient was conscious and coherent, pale looking, body weakness, swelling on both hands and hematoma on the chest. The patient transferred from St. Luke's Medical Center, Quezon City (bring home) last **August 17-19, 2023**.







