



After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was mediatly brought to GFNDy Sr. Memorial Hospital, City of Ilagan, Isabela for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** at Brgy. District 3, Gamu, Isabela last December 21, 2024. The patient was conscious and coherent. He suffered laceration on the chin and right upper eyelid (2-3 cm). Driving under influence of liquor (gin) as verbalized by the victim. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was mediatly brought to GFNDy Sr. Memorial Hospital, City of Ilagan, Isabela for proper disposition.



Team responded a **Trauma Incident** In front of Shop and Go, Brgy. Guibang, Gamu, Isabela last **December 25, 2024**. The patient suffered avulsion on left arm approximately 2-3 inches, laceration on top of the head approximately 1-2 inches, and multiple abrasion upper and lower extremities.
