PDRRMO/DART 831 Provided Medical Team and rescue ambulance in convoy and provided emergency assistance (Standby Medic), implemented health safety protocols during the visit of Ambassador Wallace Minn-Gan Chow of Taiwan to the Province of Isabela last February 18-19, 2024; and 4. Continuous dissemination of information regarding on weather updates and gale warning advisories thru radio message for transmission and the social media and continuous coordination with Regional Task Force on COVID-19 and other concerned agencies as well as continuous acquiring and dissemination of information regarding COVID-19 updates, resolutions and guidelines.
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

Team responded a *Trauma Incident* near at Shop and Go, Brgy. Guibang, Gamu, Isabela last **February 15, 2024**. The patient was suffered laceration on back of the head, abrasion on left arm and palm. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition



Team responded a *Trauma Incident* at Distirct III, Gamu, Isabela last **February 18, 2024**. The patient was conscious and suffered laceration on right eyebrow approximately 2-3 inches, abrasion on upper and lower lips. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



Team responded a *Trauma Incident* Infront of Nini's Stop Car Wash, Brgy. Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela last **February 20, 2024**. The patient was conscious and coherent. Accordingly, he suffered pain on left arm with pain scale of 8/10. After the Emergency Care Assistants (ECA) interventions, the patient was immediately brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital for proper disposition.



PDRMO/DART 831 provided transport of patient to the patient diagnosed tracheal stenosis and laryngeal squamous cell carcinoma stage IV. The patient transferred to Lung Center of the Philippines, Quezon City, Metro Manila last **February 16, 2024**.



PDRMO/DART 831 provided transport of patient to the patient diagnosed pulmonary contusion with bilateral pleural effusion, multiple ribs fracture 3rd to 7th rib right, clavicular fracture right. The patient transferred to Governor Roque B. Ablan Sr. Memorial Hospital, Laoag City, Ilocos Norte to Cagayan Valley Medical Center, Tuguegarao City, Cagayan last **February 28, 2024**.
