



Team responded to a **Medical Incident** at Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela (Ihaw-Ihaw Restaurant near at Sports Complex) last **March 16, 2022**. The patient experienced and elevated blood pressure, uncontrolled urination and defecation (discharge of poop), under maintenance of losartan 50mg due to medical history of high blood pressure. Accordingly, he felt dizziness and vomiting (black in color). After immediate intervention by Emergency Care Assistants the patient was brought to Isabela



Team responded to a **Medical Incident** at Purok 3, Bliss Village, City of Ilagan, Isabela last **March 24, 2022**. The patient have history of loss bowel movement 4 days ago, last check-up at GFNDySMH in March 21, 2022. Accordingly, he is complaining abdominal pain with scale of 5/10, and body weakness. After immediate intervention by Emergency Care Assistants the patient was brought to GFNDySMH for proper disposition.



Team responded to a **Trauma** at District 3, Gamu, Isabela last **March 12, 2022**. The patient suffered avulsion and open fracture at left leg, abrasion at chin. **Driving under the influence of alcohol** as verbalized by the victim. After immediate intervention by Emergency Care Assistants the patient was brought to Isabela GFNDySMH for further medical treatment.





**PUERTO PRINCESA CITY CONFERS 2022 MAYOR'S AWARDS TO THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF ISABELA**

March 7, 2022. The City Government of Puerto Princesa, Palawan headed by City Mayor Lucio H. Bayron awarded the Provincial Government of Isabela with the **2022 MAYOR'S AWARD** during the celebratory event at Puerto Princesa City's 150th Founding Anniversary held at Puerto Princesa Garden Island Resort on March 3, 2022.

The 2022 Mayor's Awards were conferred in recognition of modern-day heroes - individuals and organizations - who served and voluntarily aided those devastated by Typhoon Odette for love of God and man, seeing themselves connected with humanity and local communities of Puerto Princesa City, in honor of the 150th Anniversary of the island city founded by Provincial Governor Risk Reduction and Management Officer Jimmy Rivera.

The Provincial Government of Isabela sent a detachment two teams of **Project Isabela Love, Welfare and Mandates** (LWM) who is tasked to their longest endeavor to date, a 30-day humanitarian aid relief mission from January 27 to February 16, 2022 to communities affected by Typhoon Odette in Visayas and Mindanao.

The relief team composed of 38 personnel from PDRMCO, PDRMCO, DRR and PDRMCO. It is a fleet of 2 Solar Water Purifiers, 2 Trucks, 2 Bunk Beds, 8 Relief Camps loaded with premium quality Isabela Rice to Bantayan, Luto and Burigao while the relief team composed of 45 personnel from PDRMCO, PDRMCO, DRR and PDRMCO in a fleet of 2 Solar Water Purifiers, 3 Dump Trucks, 3 Tricycles, 11 LUX, 10 SHELXs, 10 Relief Camps loaded with Isabela Rice to Regions 6 and 7.




A total of 20,000 sacks of 2 kgs, one sack of Isabela Rice were distributed to Regions 6, 30,000 sacks in Region 7, 10,000 sacks in Region 10, 700 sacks to Burigao and 10,000 sacks for Puerto Princesa City, Palawan. A voluntary contribution of P5,000 from PDRMCO Isabela Employees were also distributed to DRR-Isabela City Relief and sent to DRR-Isabela for various LGU affected typhoon victims.

On November 2019, the **TEAM ISABELA HUMANITARIAN AND RELIEF MISSION** consisted a 20-member team of Typhoon Victims Relief, Typhoon Odette and relief mission in a 30-day humanitarian aid relief mission in the aftermath of typhoon to Lubbao City, Abuyog, Badian, Balingasay, Terec, Davao Oriental, City of Davao and Compostela Valley, among others.

The Isabela Relief Team was awarded the prestigious **United Magsaysay ng Kagabayan** by the NDRRMC in 2019 for its **Project Rescuers Without Borders**, guided with the philosophy, "Public service above no boundaries."
