I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (the “PDRRMO”, for brevity) as mandated by Republic Act 10121 is tasked to monitor and evaluate the implementation of the LDRRMPs and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs and ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction.

DISASTER PREVENTION AND MITIGATION, PREPAREDNESS, RESPONSE, RELIEF, RECOVERY AND REHABILITATION PROGRAM:

The PDRRMO continued to be at the forefront of Disaster Prevention and Mitigation, Preparedness, Response, Relief, Rehabilitation and Recovery program of the Provincial Government.

The program thrust of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (the “Council”, for brevity) of the Province of Isabela continued to be geared towards keeping all member-agencies ready in terms of training, equipment, and personnel.

DISASTER PREVENTION AND MITIGATION

The disaster prevention and mitigation program of the PDRRMO continued to lessen the potential impacts of hazards by reducing vulnerabilities and exposure, and enhancing capacities of communities by the following measures:

1. For 365 days in 2023, the PDRRMO monitored PAGASA weather updates, the rate of inflow and outflow and the resultant water level of Magat reservoir, and the status of overflow bridges. The information gathered were cascaded to all local chief executives, all local DRRM Officers, and all members of the Council through Viber groups. The armed forces, the police, and the fire bureau were also kept in the loop.

Whenever there were hazards, the PDRRMO alerted the public through announcements through media partners, as well as by posts in social media and by sending text blasts through its Text Messaging Alert System (TMAS). Of course, all local chief executives, all local DRRM Officers, and all members of the Council were also alerted through Viber groups. The armed forces, the police, and the fire bureau were alerted as well. Whenever there were gale warnings, coastal residents were alerted. Their local DRRM Offices and local social welfare and development offices were reminded to implement the “*No Sailing, No Fishing, and No Swimming Policy*” and to pre-position and distribute food packs to fisherfolks who, for safety, were prevented from fishing.

2. Safety measures were continued to be strictly observed in the conduct emergency response, inter-facility transfer, and mobility assistance by assessing the condition and history of a patient; and

DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

The disaster preparedness program of the PDRRMO is designed to capacitate communities in anticipating, coping, and recovering from the negative impacts of emergency occurrences and hazards.

1. The PRRMO participated in all quarterly nationwide simultaneous earthquake drills (NSED). Banners were posted in public areas and safety tips were flashed on the office-operated roadside LED wall and in social media platforms. The Office furnished copies of the Memorandum No. 18 series of 2023 to the different offices of the Provincial Government of Isabela in support on the advocacy of the National Government, through the Office of the Civil Defense, in promoting earthquake preparedness and disaster resiliency.
3. The PRRMO continued to be consistent in disseminating and posting up-to-date information and advisories pertaining to any incoming tropical cyclones and other weather disturbances, Magat Dam updates and advisories, plus the status of national and local roads and overflow bridges. Weather updates and sea conditions of the coastal towns were posted in the different social media platforms and on the LED wall located at the northbound side of the Maharlika Highway in front of the PRRMC-BFP Building for the information of the general public.
4. The PRRMO continued to capacitate communities and agencies with the necessary skills, knowledge, and capabilities to help them cope with and recover from the impacts of hazards. As shown in its monthly accomplishment reports, the PRRMO conducted several community-based DRRM trainings.
5. When typhoons struck, the PRRMO alerted the public through various means and it deployed water search and rescue personnel, floating assets, rescue vehicles, and ambulances in areas susceptible to flooding.

DISASTER RESPONSE

The disaster response program of the PRRMO continued to aim to provide life preservation and met the basic subsistence needs of affected population based on acceptable standards during or immediately after a hazard.

1. The PRRM Office responded to 269 medical and 406 trauma incidents, majority of which were based on road crashes. It performed 243 inter-facility patient transfers as well as 8 emergency child births. The PRRMO, through its DART Rescue 831 group, provided assistance to 1,279 individuals in 2023.
2. The PRRMO established and operated a motorist assistance center during the Holy Week and All Saints Day periods. All city and municipal DRRM Offices and all city and municipal police stations were instructed to activate their respective public assistance centers in strategic locations along highways, riversides, and beaches, and to continuously monitor their respective areas of responsibility (AOR) for untoward incidents. They were also instructed to identify auto repair shops where they may refer vehicle breakdowns.
3. From August 23 to 27, 2023, the PRRMO deployed a team to assist in the delivery of 6 truckloads of Isabela rice to Legazpi City, Albay for families displaced by the threat of eruption of Mayon Volcano.

5. The PDRRMO led the search and rescue operations involving a Cessna 206 that crashed in a Sierra Madre mountain in Divilacan, Isabela from January 25 to March 16, 2023.
 6. The PDRRMO established and operated a roadside motorist assistance center from April 3-7, 2023 during the Holy Week and summer vacation periods in front at the PDRRMC-BFP Building, Capitol Compound, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela.
 7. From October 22-26, 2023, the PDRRMO, through its DART Rescue 831 Water Search and Rescue (WASAR) Team, conducted the retrieval of the body of a drowning victim at San Pablo, Isabela.
 8. The PDRRMO, through its DART Rescue 831, provided medical assistance to employees and clients of the PGI who experienced dizziness and nausea after the October 4, 2023 earthquake.
 9. From July 25 to 27, 2023, during Super Typhoon “Egay”, the PDRRMO deployed 5 WASAR teams to Cabagan; Sta. Maria; and Sto. Tomas.
 10. From July 26 to 28, 2023 and again from August 30 to September 1, 2023, the PDRRMO conducted water purification and distribution operations in disaster-stricken areas after Super Typhoon “Egay” in the Province of Cagayan.

DISASTER REHABILITATION AND RECOVERY

Rehabilitation and Recovery program of the PDRRM Office remained to be aimed to restore and improve facilities, livelihood and living conditions and organizational capacities of affected communities, and reduce disaster risks in accordance with the “*building back better*” principle.

With the help and active participation of the community and of the Provincial Government of Isabela, the PDRRMO instituted proactive measures in reducing disaster risk factors. The Provincial Government of Isabela always sees to it that the communities affected are always assisted in restoring their living conditions by rebuilding their livelihood and damaged infrastructures. The office also extended efforts in providing

humanitarian assistance to lessen the burden of victims of natural disasters during recovery and capacitating the community by conducting community-based DRRM trainings and other disaster and complex emergency related trainings to better prepare them should disaster come.

III. OUR MISSION

“The program thrust of the PROVINCIAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL (PDRRMC) of the Province of Isabela shall be pursued by keeping all member-agencies ready in terms of Training, Equipment and Personnel. The PDRRMC’s inherent duty for public safety dictates the provision of Area Security, Search and Rescue, Recovery, Evacuation, Relief Operations and Rehabilitation of affected areas in the province.

IV. NOTABLE ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR 2023

Gawad Kalasag (Kalamidad at Sakuna Labanan, Sariling Galing Ang Kaligtasan) Search for Excellence in DRRM and Humanitarian Assistance serves as a recognition and award scheme of the country for various stakeholders who promote and implement DRRM, climate change adaptation and humanitarian programs that protect and shield high-risk communities against extreme hazards and render them more capable of addressing their vulnerabilities.

December 11, 2023 – The Province of Isabela received an award for being “Beyond Compliant” in the National Gawad Kalasag Seal for Excellence in Disaster Risk Reduction and Management and Humanitarian Assistance. The award was received during the 23rd Gawad Kalasag National Awarding Ceremony held at The Manila Hotel on December 11, 2023.

Our ultimate goal in Isabela is to serve the people. The opportunity to serve and raising the bar in the culture of preparedness and resiliency is a reward in itself, far more important than all the awards and accolades combined.

A. ON DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

PDRRMO/DART Rescue 831 acquired brand new rescue equipment to add to its existing stocks/inventory to equip rescuers in the fulfilment of its growing mandate.

B. ON DISASTER RESPONSE

- a. Construction of the Provincial Emergency Operations Center.
- b. Deployment of Water Sanitation Team to provide potable drinking water at Alcala and Abulug, Cagayan that was affected by Typhoon Egay and Goring.
- c. Delivered 30 tons of Isabela rice to families displaced by a preemptive evacuation due to a possible eruption of Mount Mayon in the Province of Albay

C. PLANS, PROGRAMS, AND ACTIVITIES

- a. Conducted continuing training and education to enhance the already-acquired knowledge and skills of the Provincial and Municipal DRRM Council through participatory and community-based vulnerability assessments as the baseline data to mainstream Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Adaptation in local development planning process from provincial to city/municipal down to barangay levels.
- b. 32 trainings in various courses were given to 878 participating individuals from the armed forces, PGI Safety Officers, local government personnel, rescue groups, and hospital staff both inside and outside the province. The trainings conducted were on DOH-mandated courses in Basic Life Support with Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Standard First Aid, and Ambulance Management Training Course.
- c. Technical Rescue Training participated by representatives of the different municipalities and rescue teams in the province were conducted in 5 Water Search and Rescue (WASAR) participated by 125 individuals; 1 Mountain Search and Rescue (MOSAR) participated by 30 individuals and 1 Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) participated by ten (10) individuals.
- d. Provision of guidance to Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils of all Local Government Units (LGUs).
- e. A training on the Formulation of Efficient LDRRM Fund Investment Plans was given to all the C/MDRRMO's of Isabela at Country Inn Hotel, Sta. Ana, Cagayan July 19-21, 2023.
- f. Maintained all records of emergency/rescue responses and monitoring of the weather disturbances that may enter our area of responsibility;
- g. Preparation of DART Rescue 831 Personnel to respond in any worst-case scenarios, unfortunate and catastrophic and emergencies through skillful, keen and incisive planning - Incident Command System - Incident Action Plan (ICS-IAP) and preparation;
- h. Actively participated in the prevention, control and other activities of the Provincial Task Force on Covid-19 and other Emerging Infectious Diseases by following and assisting the PITF on Covid-19 in the strict enforcement of the guidelines and protocols imposed by the National Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF); and
- i. Performed other functions, duties and responsibilities as maybe directed by the Provincial Governor and Chairman of the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council.
