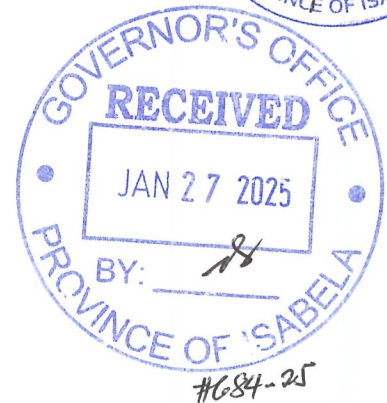

BRO Sapat na Seguridad para sa Magsasaka (SSS-M) **Social Protection for every Small Farmers**

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

BRO Sapat na Seguridad para sa mga Magsasaka or BRO SSS-M is a social protection program of the Provincial Government of Isabela (PGI) for the small farmers in cases of sickness, maternity, disability, retirement, and funeral.

The PGI undertook to initially subsidize the monthly contributions of the farmers and farm workers amounting to P570.00. With this contribution, the small farmers can avail all the benefits of SSS after twenty-four (24) months of paying the contributions.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The BRO SSS-M aims to provide protection or to insure every small farmer against the hazards of:

- a.) Sickness
- b.) Maternity
- c.) Disability
- d.) Death
- e.) Funeral
- f.) Retirement or old age
- g.) Unemployment
- h.) Other contingencies resulting in loss of income or financial burden

BRO *Sapat na Seguridad para Sa mga Magsasaka* (SSSM) has enrolled a total of one thousand nine hundred seventy seven (1,977) marginalized farmers as of December 2024 wherein 1,351 of them are still enrolled in the program and 626 have already been paid 24 months of contribution. For the year 2024, the program has catered to 1,239 Tobacco Farmers and 112 NMIAC Members of which all of them are still currently paying. (Through the funds of the PGI) The farmer graduates of BRO SSSM are encouraged to continue paying their monthly premium contribution so that they can reap the benefits and privileges of being members of Social Security System (SSS) when the time comes.

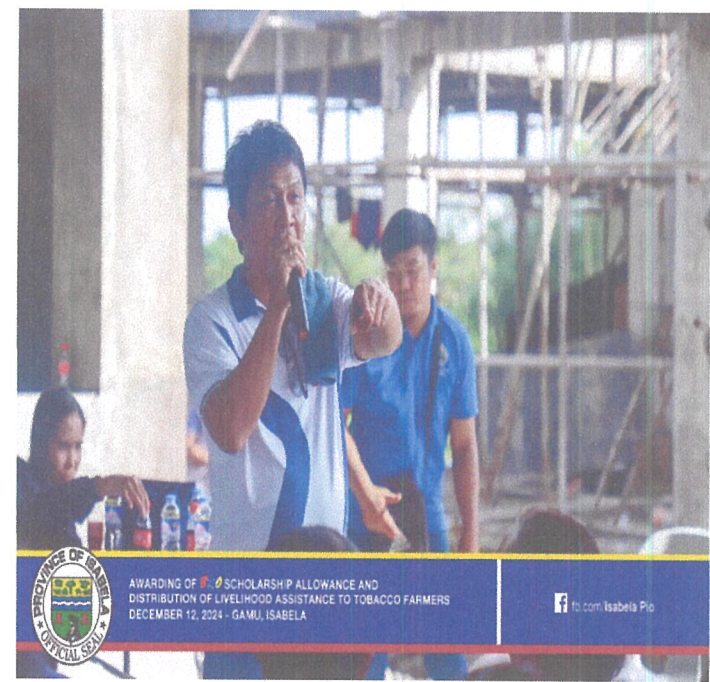

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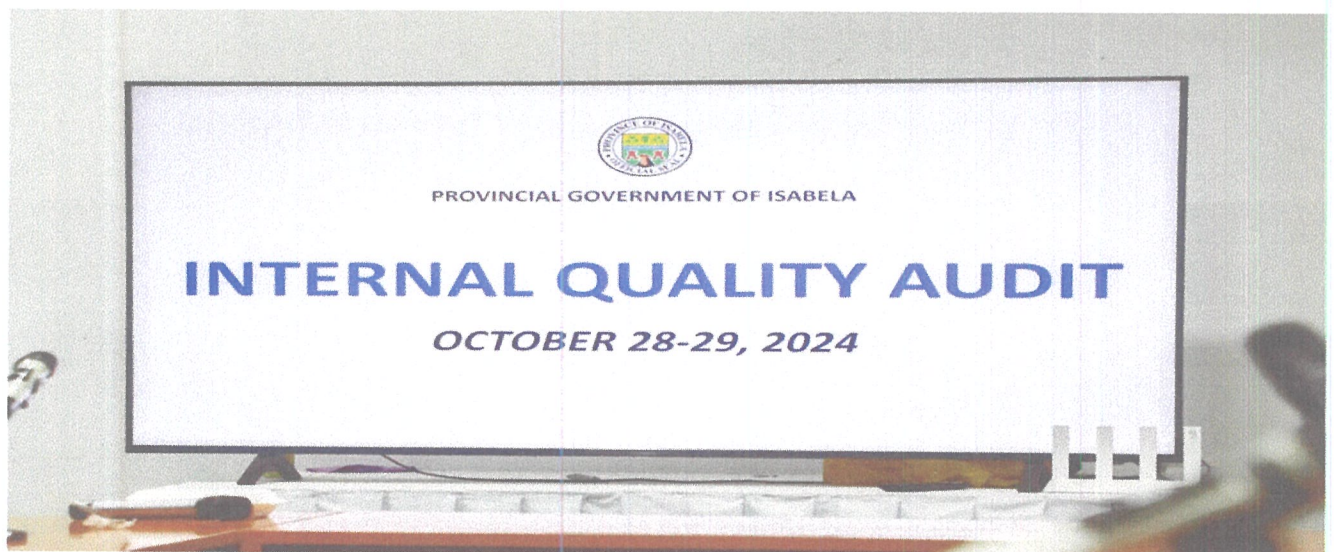

BRO PAG-IBIG SAVINGS PROGRAM AND AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAM FOR EVERY SMALL FARMERS

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

BRO PAG IBIG is the twelfth program of the Provincial Government of Isabela (PGI) launched in January 2015. Primarily, it offers savings program and affordable housing program to each and every small farmer in the Province of Isabela.

BRO PAG IBIG is a climate change adaptation program of the PGI. It aims to help farmers lessen their vulnerability to the effects of climate change by helping them build sturdy houses through affordable housing program.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

BRO PAG IBIG program aims to enroll 10,000 small farmers of the Province of Isabela to be a member PAG-IBIG fund for them to enjoy the benefits of the program such as:

- a.) **Savings**
- b.) **Tax free dividends**
- c.) **Death Benefit grants**
- d.) **Short-term or Multi-Purpose loans for:**
 - Emergency
 - Tuition Fees
 - Medical Needs
 - In case of calamity
- e.) **Affordable housing loans with low interest rates and longer repayment periods.**

ACCOMPLISHMENT

The BRO Pag-IBIG Program has enrolled a total of two thousand nine hundred fifty (1,950) marginalized farmers from different municipalities of Isabela as of December 2024 wherein one thousand three hundred ninety five (1,395) of them are still enrolled in the program and five hundred fifty five (555) have already been paid 24 months of premium contribution. For the year 2024, the program has catered to 1,276 Tobacco Farmers and 119 NMIAC Members of which all of them are still currently paying. (Through the funds of the PGI)
