CHAPTER 1 PROGRAM OVERVIEW

BRO for Education is the local government unit's Provincial Scholarship Program. With BRO-Ed, every farmer-family is guaranteed a college scholarship slot as a special assistance to small farmers who dream of having at least one college graduate in the family. This aims at reducing the financial burdens of farmers in the education of their children, motivating them towards greater productivity.

The program has two components, the Academic Scholarship Program for those who graduated from Senior High School with honors (With Highest Honors to With Honors) and the Non-Academic Scholarship Program or the regular scholarship for those who are interested to pursue college education even without honors.

1.1. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The Provincial Scholarship Program aims to:

1. Provide college scholarship opportunities to Isabeleños prioritizing the sons and daughters of small farmers in the province.
2. Help families' especially small farming and indigent families lessen their financial burden in sending their children to college education.
3. Promote and support the "education for all" by providing Isabeleño youth equal educational opportunities.

1.2. POLICIES AND GUIDELINES

- a. The BRO for Education is the Provincial Scholarship Program of the Provincial Government of Isabela pursuant to Ordinance No. 07, s. 2018 also known as ***"An Ordinance Further Amending Ordinance No. 09, series of 2015 and Adopt a New Policy- grant in Order to Adjust to the Needs of Isabeleño Youth vis-à-vis the implementation of the Republic Act and Republic Act 10533 or Enhanced Basic Education Act of 2013."*** As part of the amended ordinance adopting the new K to 12 policy-guidelines in giving awards and recognition as a new basis in giving incentives/benefits to students/benefits to students/scholars who graduated with Honors (Academic Scholar) With Highest Honors Php 5,000.00, With High Honors Php 4000.00 and With Honors Php 3000.00 during Senior High School, semestral allowance shall be granted while for those who graduated from Senior High School without honors (Non-

Academic Scholar) a Book And Lodging Allowance amounting Php 3000.00 shall be granted for every semester.

- b. BRO for Education guarantees a scholarship college slot as a special assistance to small farmers who dream of having at least one college graduate in the family. This aims at reducing the financial burdens of small farmers in the education of their children, motivating them towards greater productivity.
- c. The “One Scholar per Farming Family” shall be adopted as a policy of the BRO-Ed.

CHAPTER 2
2018 PERFORMANCE REPORT

2.2. QUALITATIVE PERFORMANCE

1. A total of **2,790** students were enrolled in BRO for Education for 2nd Semester for School Year 2017-18 and a total of **10,220** students were enrolled for 1st Semester School Year 2018-2019.
2. A total of **873** students availed the **Academic Scholarship** program while about **1,917** students availed the **Non-Academic Scholarship** for 2nd semester School Year 2017-2018.
3. A total of **2,407** students availed the **Academic Scholarship** program while about a total of **7,813** students availed the **Non- Academic Scholarship** for 1st Semester for School Year 2018-2019.
4. This year, the Provincial Government of Isabela has spent a total amount of **Php 37,845,369.00** for the benefits of its scholars.
5. For 2nd Semester School Year 2017-2018 the highest bulk of scholars came from the biggest campuses of **Isabela State University-Cauayan** with a total of **351** in first and **Isabela College in the Arts and Technolgy** and **Isabela State University-Jones** in second and third with total of **302** and **242**, respectively.
6. This year for 1st Semester School Year 2018-2019 the highest bulk of scholars came from **City of Ilagan** with a total of **1,560** in first and City of Cauayan and Municipality of Echague in second and third with total of **827** and **569**, respectively.
7. Academic scholars came from **Isabela State University-Echague**, with a total of **86** students for 2nd Semester School Year 2017-2018 while for 1st Semester School Year 2018-2019 a total of **441** students came from the **Municipality of Ilagan**, shared the highest number of Academic Scholars enrolled in different Universities and Colleges within and outside the province.
8. The scholarship program has increased its number of scholars with its partner public and private schools for this year. This is due to the implementation of the new educational system known as the Enhance Basic Education Curriculum or K-12 has its first batch of Senior High School graduates.

9. A total of **9,179 scholars** whose parents are **farmers** availed the program.

10. As compared to previous year's average number of **2,976**, this year has a percentage increase of **70.88% (10,220)**.

CHAPTER 3
2018 ACTIVITIES

Activity : **BRO-Ed SCHOOL CARAVAN**

- Objective :
1. To educate the youth about the BRO for Education.
 2. To shape leaders from the different universities and colleges in the Province.

NARRATIVE

The BRO School Caravan aims to orient BRO scholars from the universities and colleges about important details with regards to the new policies and guidelines of the Provincial Scholarship Program commonly known as the Bojie-Rodito Opportunities for Education. An election is also administered to the new set of Lider ni BRO (LIBRO) Officers as they serve as leaders to all BRO-Ed scholars. It was followed by an orientation of the BRO Life and Accident. The distribution of Bro-Ed Certificates, BRO-Ed IDs and the Bro-Insurance Card was also done during the caravan.

Second part of the caravan is a symposium with the Supreme Student Council (SSC), Student Body Organization (SBO) and the newly elected Lider ni BRO (LIBRO). It centered on the discussion about the Youth Organization Registration Program of Isabela (YORPi) spearheaded by the Officer-in-Charge of the Provincial Youth Development Office. He expounded the benefits and privileges of an organization once it is officially registered to (YORPi). He also discussed on how and where to register. The symposium objective is to encourage the student organizations to be part of the program to embolden the participation of the youth as partners of the provincial government.
