Bojie-Rodito Opportunities – Paneguro Sa Pananim (BRO PSP)

PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

The Agreement reached by the Provincial Government and the Philippine Crop Insurance Corporation provides for the capacity of Small Farmers to recover their losses from natural calamities like flooding, typhoons, quakes, and Climate Change-related weather conditions, and insect and pest infestation. Qualified farmers are enrolled in the program which covers a planting season through harvest time. The PCIC shall indemnify farmers and pay them directly upon completion and verification of documentary requirements and evaluation of crop damage.

GOALS/ OBJECTIVES:

To provide eligible small farmers a crop insurance premium for an acceptable coverage to recover part of their farming capital during calamities either natural or pest infestations.

ACCOMPLISHMENT:

IMPACT:


- The increase of enrollment indicates that small farmers are now aware of this program because of massive information dissemination
- The affected small farmers claimed their indemnity checks after their enrolled areas where damaged by drought and flooding.
- Small farmers are now secured that whatever happens, the PGI will give support to Rice and Corn Producers in the province.

The Governor awarded the indemnity claims (P2,718,552.00) of small farmers (760) enrolled under the BRO – PSP who were affected by Typhoon Ompong. This is in collaboration with the Philippine Crop Insurance Corporation (PCIC) wherein the Provincial Government of Isabela through the Honorable Governor Faustino G. Dy III sponsors the full crop insurance premium rate to corn and rice small farmers of the province.
