




Bamboo Benchmarking Mission	In partnership with DTI Isabela and the Isabela Bamboo Association Council (IsaBAC), this activity is part of the continuing efforts of both the government & other entities to accelerate the growth of the bamboo industry sector in the province; and to deepen the appreciation of our local bamboo stakeholders & LGUs on the different bamboo business models of the other regions.	Together with representatives from the DTI Regional & Provincial Office & members of the Regional & Provincial Bamboo Association Councils, the ENRO representative joined the Bamboo Benchmarking Mission conducted in Carranglan & Pantabangan, Nueva Ecija; Lubao & Mabalacat, Pampanga; Bayambang & Aguilar, Pangasinan; and in Baguio City which aimed to bring Region 02's bamboo stakeholders & LGUs to become successful Community-Based & Industrial-Based Bamboo Businesses & Research Centers; to further appreciate the industry's potentials; and to set explicit directions to boost the bamboo industry as wood substitute.

Processing and Issuance of Permits		For this Month of February, this office received Six (6) CSAG Permit Applications from the different Quarry Locations within the province with corresponding administrative/processing fees collected by the Provincial Treasurer’s Office amounting to Sixty Seven Thosand Nine Hundred Eighty (P67,980.00) pesos only.
B. Accreditation of Haulers	The ENR Office is responsible in field verification and evaluation of quarry area to determine compliance of permit holders/haulers to environmental laws, rules and regulations. Also, regular monitoring of extraction of sand and gravel and other quarry resources is conducted which shall serve as basis for the collection of taxes and other related fees by the Provincial Treasurer’s Office.	For the Month of February 2020, a total of 110 haulers/dealers/traders and retailers in trading mineral products and by-products were accredited with corresponding fees collected by the PTO amounting to Two Hundred Seventy Seven Thousand Two Hundred (Php277,200) pesos and Forty Eight Thousand Five Hundred (Php48,700) pesos for Accreditation Sticker.
