Number of seedlings produced/propagated = <b>327 forest and fruit tree seedlings</b> - 37 Cacao, 130 Raintree, 80 Narra and 80 Bolong eta seedlings; A total of <b>2,570</b> assorted seedlings were disposed to various requesting constituents composed of 355 fruit-bearing tree seedlings, 175 Coconut seedlings, 100 Bamboo propagules and 1,740 forest tree seedlings; For Clonal Operation, a total of <b>350</b> cloned Molave seedlings were already transplanted for recovery and later for hardening.

B. Updating/Consolidation of Provincial 10-Year Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan	As technical arm of the Provincial Solid Waste Management Board (PSWMB), we are obliged to consolidate the 10-Year ESWM Plan of all cities and municipalities in order to update every two years the Provincial ESWM Plan. These plans will be included in the preferred plans, programs and activities of the PSWMB chaired by Hon. Rodolfo T. Albano III. Hence, we requested and collected the said plans of all municipalities and cities as our basis in updating our Provincial 10-Year ESWM Plan.	Continued updating the Provincial 10-Year ESWM Plan and incorporated the data of Palanan, Isabela. Also updated the status of Sanitary Landfill Facilities within the province- 9 SLF were operational with approved ECCs, 1 SLF with approved ECC but not yet operational, 5 municipalities have a Memorandum of Understanding with Cauayan City for the utilization of its SLF, 1 municipality with on-going construction of SLF and 20 municipalities with Residual Containment Area.
C. Anti-smoke Belching Campaign	Partnership activity with DENR-EMB R02 and LTO R02 in monitoring compliance to anti-smoke belching campaign thru the use of opacimeter machine. Accreditation of Haulers		For the month of July 2020, <b>a total of 12 haulers/dealers/traders and retailers</b> in trading mineral products and by-products were accredited and issued a total of 46 accreditation stickers with corresponding fees collected by the PTO amounting to Thirty Thousand Two Hundred Forty (Php30,240.00) pesos and Four Thousand Six Hundred (Php4,600.00) pesos.
