A. Processing and Issuance of Permits		For the month of May, this Office received One (1) CSAG Permit Application from Vedasto D. Villanueva at Cabisera 22, City of Ilagan, Isabela with corresponding administrative/processing fees collected by the Provincial Treasurer's Office amounting to Eleven Thousand Three Hundred Thirty Three (P11,330.00) pesos only.

The ENR Office is responsible in field verification and evaluation of quarry area to determine compliance of permit holders/haulers to B. Accreditation of Haulers environmental laws, rules and regulations. Also, regular monitoring of extraction of sand and gravel and other quarry resources is conducted which shall C. Site Verification and Inspection of serve as basis for the collection of Mining/Quarry Sites taxes and other related fees by the Provincial Treasurer's Office. Field Monitoring of Quarry Areas

For this month, a total of 14 haulers/dealers/traders and retailers in trading mineral products and by-products were accredited with corresponding fees collected by the PTO amounting to Thirty Five Thousand Two Hundred Eighty (Php35,280.00) pesos and Three Thousand One Hundred (Php3,100.00) pesos for Accreditation Sticker.

For this month, a total of 92,429.40 cu. m. of quarry resources were extracted - 1,882.00 cu.m Ordinary Earth, 78,302.00 cu.m Mixed, 3,282.00 G1/S1 and 8,963.40.00 Boulders with corresponding value of P3,437,707.00, representing P56,460.00 Ordinary Earth, P2,740,570.00 Mixed, P147,690.00 G1/S1 and P492,987.00 Boulders.
