- Production/Propagation and Disposition of seedlings	Production, propagation and procurement of seedling stock and disposition of seedlings	Production/Procurement of seedlings = 12,696 forest and fruit tree seedlings - 2,556 produced/propagated forest and fruit-tree seedlings and 10,140 procured assorted fruit-tree seedlings: Disposition of seedlings = A total of 3,205 forest and fruit tree seedlings including bamboo propagules were disposed/distributed to various beneficiaries for this month.
- Maintenance works	Maintenance of Provincial Nursery; Operation of Clonal Nursery; Brushing, ring weeding and greening of two nurseries; arrangement, and sorting of seedlings for hardening; seed and collection and propagation; and other activities that may be assigned	ENRO personel and the 6 hired laborers (Job Order) conducted the maintenance and operation of Provincial and Clonal nurseries. This also include landscaping and beautification of the ENR Office premises and assisted in site preparation activities for the tree planting along Ilagan-Divilacan Road and cleanup drives

Activities Undertaken in Support of IDRRIP	Patrol works and monitoring activities and maintenance of reforestation areas; Tree re-planting along IDR roadside stretch and cleanup drives within the vicinities of Disiope and Henekan River systems	ISEP-TF and ENRO personnel conducted monitoring and maintenance of reforestation areas. On September 23 and 24, 2020, the ENRO and ISEP-TF personnel conducted cleanup drive and re-planting activities along the Ilagan-Divilacan Road and river systems near thereat in observance of various environment events for the month of September such as National Cleanup and International Coastal Cleanup day, National Bamboo Day and Sierra Madre Day. A total of 900 seedlings were planted and 10 sacks of solid wastes were collected during the two-day activities. The team also put-up placards/signages initially at Disiope and Henekan rivers to give reminders to people who enter and traverse the IDR to properly disposed their solid wastes.
