The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities within the Capitol Compound and Provincially Operated Hospitals. Most departments are adhering to waste segregation policies and improved waste management practices. A total of **3,664.55 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities, and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).

This process follows the principles of RA 9003 (Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000) and RA 6969 (Toxic Substances and Hazardous and Nuclear Wastes Control Act of 1990) in managing solid waste by classifying them into four categories; Biodegradable, Recyclable, Residual and Hazardous wastes and accurately weighing the wastes for tracking of resources and thorough documentation to track the trend of the wastes managed.
