Monitoring and Inspection

As part of the Environment and Natural Resources Office (ENRO) initiative to enforce solid waste management practices of different offices, departments and establishments within the Capitol Compound. On December 19, the team briefly inspected the Lingap Center, Provincial Veterinary Office and Coastal Extension Offices to ensure the full compliance with E.O No. 28 and Memorandum No. 13, Series of 2024.

Summary of Waste Disposal

The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities within the Capitol Compound and Provincially Operated Hospitals. Most departments are adhering to waste segregation policies and improved waste management practices. A total of **3,838.36 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities, and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).


