#### 1. *Recyclable Waste*

- Total Collected: 952.19 kilograms
- Disposal Through: ENRO Materials Recovery Facility (MRF)

#### 2. *Residual Waste*

- Total Collected: 1,924.83 kilograms
- Disposal Through: City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF)

#### 3. *Hazardous Waste*

- Total Collected: 765.35 kilograms
- Disposal Through: ENRO Materials Recovery Facility (MRF)

#### 4. *Biodegradable Waste*

- Total Collected: 2,030.30 kilograms
- Disposal Through: ENRO Compost Heap and Vermi-composting

### Conclusion:

The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities within the Capitol Compound. Most departments are adhering to waste segregation policies and improved waste management practices. A total of **5,672.66 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).
