- Disposal Through: City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF)

- Total Collected: 776.34 kilograms
- Disposal Through: ENRO Materials Recovery Facility (MRF)

4. *Biodegradable Waste*


- Total Collected: 1,562.92 kilograms

Conclusion:

The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities within the Capitol Compound. Most departments are adhering to waste segregation policies and improved waste management practices. A total of **4,913.20 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).
