



Summary of Waste Disposal:



The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities within the Capitol Compound. Most departments are adhering to waste segregation policies and improved waste management practices. A total of **3,757.33 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities, and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).
