Monitoring and Inspection:

ENRO personnel conducted daily/weekly monitoring and inspection of garbage as per RA 9003 also known as Ecological Solid Waste Management of 2000 within capitol compound.

Activities Undertaken:

- Inspected garbage as per waste classification.
- Informed responsible person to segregate garbage properly before conveying to ENRO Residual Containment Area (RCA).
- Reiterated E.O No. 28 and Memorandum No. 13 Series of 2024.


These are the observations, to wit:

- 1. Some offices at Queen Isabela Park doesn't have their own garbage bin.
- 2. Garbage bin not properly labelled.
- 3. Prolonged waste accumulated in their offices before bringing to ENRO RCA.

Recommendations:

- 1. All offices must bring their segregated garbage to ENRO RCA on daily or weekly basis pursuant to E.O No. 28.
- 2. All offices must maintain properly labelled garbage bin in order to avoid mixed wastes.

Summary of Waste Disposal:



The weekly summary report highlights the waste generation and disposal activities within the Capitol Compound. Most departments are adhering to waste segregation policies and improved waste management practices. A total of **4,057.07 kilograms** (recyclable, residual, hazardous, and biodegradable) were collected and disposed through the ENRO MRF, Compost Heap and Vermicomposting Facilities, and to the City of Ilagan Sanitary Landfill Facility (SLF).
