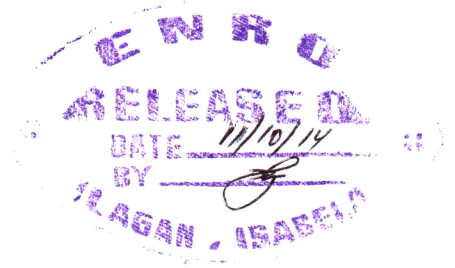



The registration started upon arrival of participants coming from the twenty seven (27) Barangays of Sto. Tomas, Afterwhich, the program started at around 9:00 in the morning. Then, Municipal Treasurer Talosig acknowledged the participants/farmer delegates coming from the different barangays of the municipality, followed by acknowledgement of PGI Heads and staff done by Mr. John Soriano.

In behalf of the Municipality of Sto. Tomas, Sangguning Bayan Member Hon. Antonio Talaue, Jr. gave his welcome remarks and expressed his deepest gratitude to the Provincial Government for bringing the programs and services for the welfare and enjoyment of constituents. Afterwhich, the Hon. Governor and Vice-Governor delivered their speech to the community conveying their love and support to the LGU of Sto. Tomas in their future activities and projects following the awarding of financial assistance to the twenty seven (27) Barangays amounting to Php 150,000.00 (Php 100,000.00 for infrastructure and Php 50,000.00 for Town Fiesta, Lakbay Aral, Health Insurance & Iglo each as provincial counterparts to be implemented at the Barangay Level).

It was followed by the presentation of the different programs and services of the Provincial Government briefly presented by respective focal persons. They discussed the different services for which the farmers can avail to start (BROs ASP, PSP, LAMFP, and livelihood); Health (BROs Healthcare & PhilHealth); Insurance (BROs PNB Gen & SSS) and Scholarship (BRO Education) for their children.


Subsequently, after showcasing the basic services of the Province and just after the lunch break, this office through its focal person formally opened the table to entertain and assist the issues and concerns of the constituents bringing with them their routine slip about environmental services. 
