## POST FARMERS' CONGRESS REPORT October 24, 2014

CITY OF ILAGAN, ISABELA

The registration started upon arrival of participants coming from the ninety one (91) Barangays of the City of Ilagan. Afterwhich, the Provincial Governor Hon. Faustino G. Dy III together with Hon. Vice-Governor Antonio T. Albano arrived at the venue following the commencement of the Farmers' Congress at around 10:00 o'clock in the morning.

In behalf of the City Government of Ilagan, Hon. Mayor Jose Marie L. Diaz gave his welcome remarks and expressed his deepest gratitude to the Provincial Government for bringing the programs and services for the welfare and enjoyment of constituents and extending its assistance for the rehabilitation and air conditioning of its Community Center in the amount of Ten (10) Million Pesos. Afterwhich, the Hon. Governor and Vice-Governor delivered their speech to the community conveying their all-time love and support to the whole LGU Ilagan as well as in their future projects and undertakings following the awarding of financial assistance to the ninety one (91) Barangays amounting to Php 150,000.00 (Php 100,000.00 for infrastructure and Php 50,000.00 for Town Fiesta, Lakbay Aral, Health Insurance & Iglo each as provincial counterparts to be implemented at the Barangay Level).

It was followed by the presentation of the different programs and services of the Provincial Government to which the first speaker was Mrs. Nimfa Aquino, OPA Asst. Officer who discussed the PPP program and presented in a nutshell some other services for which the farmers can avail and where put all together in a package to start (BROs ASP, PSP, LAMFP, and livelihood); Health (BROs Healthcare & PhilHealth); Insurance (BROs PNB Gen & SSS) and Scholarship (BRO Education) for their children. It was followed by brief presentation of focal persons with their respective services.

Subsequently, after showcasing the basic services of the Province and just after the lunch break, this office through its focal person formally opened the table to entertain and assist the issues and concerns of the constituents bringing with them their routine slip about environmental services, we were able to cater four (4) clients with their concerns as follows:
