I. Submitted is the monthly operational accomplishment report of Isabela Provincial Jail covering the period from March 1 - 31, 2021.

SUMMARY

The Isabela Provincial Jail inmates' population for the period is 261.

1. SITUATION UPDATE:

a. On Inmates/detainees Escort and Security:

- For the period, a total of **One Hundred Thirty One** (131) inmates/detainees were escorted and secured while attending Court hearings in the twelve (12) Regional Trial Courts in the Province.

- For the Period, inmates clean & green program is being undertaken by way of planting different vegetables as their livelihood program, while other inmates were involved in handy Craft projects like basket, table and picture frame making, using cogon as their major materials, others were involved in backyard poultry and piggery projects. The maintenance of these projects is being supervised by IPJ personnel.

g. Moral Recovery Program:

- For the period, this Office has no moral and spiritual activities to inmates due to pandemic covid19 and ordered modified general community quarantine.

h. Recreational Activities:

- For the Period, there are several recreational activities within jail compound to wit:

 - b) Volleyball
 - c) Badminton
 - d) Table tennis
 - e) Chess

i. Visitation:

- For the period, relatives and friends of inmates we're not allowed to visit in this jail as a part of safety precautions to prevent the pandemic disease covid19.

j. Security Consciousness:


- The installation of CCTV Camera inside and within the perimeter premises of the IPJ was already completed and is now operational.

II. Other Concern:

- On March 11, 2021, the Isabela Provincial Jail Personnel's and PDL's participated to the 2021 First Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill.
- That on or about 16 0500H March 21, Team led by the Assistant Provincial Warden left Isabela Provincial Jail Office to act as security escort to one high profile PDL named **Delilah Padilla**, a member of the NPA charge before the RTC Br. 11, Tuao, Cagayan for the following crime; 1 - Viol. Of Sec. 1 of RA 9516 under C.C No. 2135-T, 2 – Viol. Of RA 10591 under C.C No. 2136-T, 3 – Murder under C.C No. 2137-T, 4 – Frustrated Murder under C.C No. 2138-T. Re her schedule arraignment on the above stated date. The team arrived office at about 1745H of same date w/ no untoward incident.
- On March 28, 2021, Dra. Lennie Pua Bulan of Skin Enare Aesthetic Clinic, Ilagan City, Isabela voluntary delivered and handover 290 packs of snacks intended to PDL's duly received by the Officer of the Day.
- Handy Craft projects continuously undertaken by inmates, open for sale to the public the income generated will accrue to prisoner concerned.
- Likewise, inmates who has knowledge in carpentry jobs, continuously accepting furniture making as their source of meager income, carpentry tools was already completed, through the initiative of the Provincial Warden.

III. Problems/Recommendation:

- Lack of fire power.
- The procurement of fire power of this office is requested and highly recommended to upgrade old and primitive hand guns which were issued to the custodial force/prison guard since the activation of Isabela Provincial Jail.
