For the month of September 2017, the Public Safety Office participated in various activities of the Provincial Government of Isabela such as the Farmers Congress Reloaded, which aims to bring the services of the Provincial Capitol nearer to Farmers and provide all the benefits that can be obtained from the different Bojie -Rodito Opportunities programs otherwise known as the BRO programs. As part of the group visiting towns and cities across the Province, the Public Safety Office continues to disseminate necessary reading materials to create awareness on a grassroots level and demonstrate safety tips thru visual aids and the support of the Bureau of Fire Protection and the Dart 831 rescue team.

The Office, tasked to facilitate and lead the preparations on Bird Flu Outbreak in the Province, worked with the different line agencies of the Provincial Government to craft countermeasures against the avian disease by spreading awareness as well as steps taken to ensure the Province will not be affected by the outbreak.

The Isabela Provincial Public Safety Office spearheaded the 3rd Quarter Earthquake Drill conducted at the Provincial Capitol grounds on September 27, 2017 which lasted for 33 minutes. As part of the department's Plans and Programs, the Office caused the purchase of a crank siren which was utilized to sound the alarm for the said activity.

TASK FORCE BIRD FLU

In accordance with the Governor's Executive Order no 33, series of 2017, the Provincial Public Safety Office, together with the Provincial Veterinary Office, Isabela Provincial Health Office, Department of Agriculture Region-II representatives, Philippine National Police as well as other Provincial line agencies, conducted a general meeting to discuss current understanding of the avian influenza virus as well as the steps the Provincial Government has taken to prevent an outbreak in the Province. The meeting was held at the Balai Isabela Conference Hall wherein different stakeholders of the Provincial Government joined hands to provide much

needed guidance and shared their expertise with the group. Dr. Manuel Galang Jr. of the Department of Agriculture Region II was invited to provide a lecture on understanding Avian Influenza (Bird Flu) as well as an update on what the National Government is doing to prevent the spread of the virus which was first detected in some poultry farms in the Province of Pampanga.

The Provincial Administrator, Atty. Noel Manuel R. Lopez, himself an experienced Poultry farmer and owner, provided his insights during the discussion on what steps are to be taken together with the Provincial Information Officer, Provincial Veterinarian and the

Provincial Public Safety Officer among other Department Heads and representatives present during the meeting. Lastly, the Task Force composition was announced and working files were shared across the group for consolidation.



DISASTER PREPAREDNESS TOOL : THE CRANK SIREN

A vital tool on disaster preparedness, the Crank Siren was purchased to ensure wide coverage on sounding the alarm for any emergency. The SP 110A Crank Siren can be used in the absence of electricity as this is manually operated with a sound rating that can reach up to 120-130db, more than enough to cover the whole Capitol Grounds and nearby establishments. Due to its aluminum alloy frame and 9kg total weight, this mobile warning system can be easily deployed to far-flung areas where no other communication medium is available
