Kabalikat, PGI Safety Officers and Peace and Order Council counterparts throughout the month.



Discussion with LGU leaders was also in the Agenda to further broaden the reach of the Council on mat-



SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as **AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONSTRUCTION OF ANY DWELLING STRUCTURES IN LOW-LYING, FLOOD OR LANDSLIDE-PRONE AREAS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE PROVINCE OF ISABELA AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREOF;**

SECTION 2. OBJECTIVES/POLICY;

- A. To facilitate the protection of life and property from damage due to flood events by ensuring that no dwelling structures will be built in low lying areas.
- B. It is the purpose of this ordinance to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare, and to minimize public and private losses due to flood conditions in specific areas by provisions designed:
- C. To protect human life and health;
- D. To minimize the need for rescue and relief efforts associated with flooding or landslide and generally undertaken at the expense of the general public;
