MONTH AT A GLANCE

For the month of June, the Public Safety Office, led by department head Atty. Constante A. Foronda, Jr., together with Jimmy U. Rivera Sr., Assistant department head and concurrent Provincial Security Group Officer-in-Charge participated in various activities aimed at ensuring Peace and Order, Parking and Security preparations, Traffic Management, Crowd Control and emergency preparedness measures are disseminated across the Province.

The Office hosted various coordinating meetings, walk-through and board map planning in full coordination with the Isabela Police Provincial Office, City PNP, Road Safety Council members among other Gov't agency counterparts in line with the initiatives and orders of the Gov-

ernor to ensure Road Safety for all motorists by upholding and enforcing all applicable laws to instill discipline and reduce accidents and subsequent casualties.

PSO personnel continue to support the various programs and activities of the Office, true to its mandate of providing training and community awareness programs, facilitate coordinating meetings and produce updated Safety IEC materials by constantly researching new safety measures and acquiring skills and knowledge thru various trainings related to Safety and Health programs.

Also part of our mandate and to show that PSO personnel also practice the emergency evacuation processes we promote, the Office participated and performed evacuation proceedings together with the PGI

employees and guests during the 2nd Quarter National Simultaneous Earthquake Drill held last June 21, 2018 at exactly 2:00 PM.

The Office, tasked to monitor and facilitate implementation of various Road Safety Laws across the Province thru the PNP-PDRRC Quick Response Motorcycle Riders also known as the EO 18 Riders, continue to monitor operations, provide necessary reports and spread Road Safety Awareness by distributing Road Safety tips and flyers through various platforms such as the Farmers Congress Reloaded and Social Media.

For the month, the Office joined Farmers Congress activities which were held at the towns of Cabagan and Dinapigue.

EO 18 MONITORING AND OPERATIONS

The Public Safety Office and the PNP-PDRRC Quick Response Motorcycle Riders continue to work hand-in-hand in ensuring that Peace and Order as well as Road Safety and Security are of utmost importance at all times especially during major Provincial events / activities where the likelihood of disorder or chaos are at a high risk due to the volume of vehicles and

participants.

True to his commitment, 24 new motorcycles were purchased thru the initiative of the Governor for the PNP-PDRRC Quick Response Motorcycle Riders to complete the goal of having 48 fully

operational units

The Public Safety Office, in full coordination with the Isabela Police Provincial Office, held a meeting last June 14, 2018 at the GFNDY Hall, Provincial Capitol, City of Ilagan, Isabela.

Town and City Chiefs of Police, together with their investigators and representatives attended the said meeting aimed at improving Road Safety and to report on the current state of Road accidents in their respective areas.

The meeting between the Provincial Government of Isabela was facilitated by the Public Safety Office in order to

get a feel of the current implementation of Road Safety laws and more importantly gather feedback to be used as basis for resolutions being discussed by the Road Safety Council, to which the Isabela Police Provincial Office is also a member.

It was noted thru the reports that one major cause of road crashes within the Region and most specifically, the Province for the last 2 years (IPPO report covers January 2017-May 2018) involved motorized Tricycles traversing National highways which resulted to 520 accidents and 225 fatalities.
