Rivera Sr., Assistant department head and concurrent Provincial Security Group Officer-in-Charge participated in various activities for the Province. The Office joined various coordinating meetings, capability enhancement trainings and worked on confidential matters in line with the initiatives and orders of the Governor.

PSO personnel continue to support the various programs and activities of the Office, true to it's mandate of providing training and community awareness programs , facilitate coordinating meetings and

produce updated Safety IEC materials by constantly researching new safety measures and acquiring skills and knowledge thru various trainings related to Safety and Health programs.



2019 BAMBANTI FESTIVAL

The Office, tasked to monitor and facilitate implementation of various Road Safety Laws across the Province thru the PNP-PDRMC Quick Response Motorcycle Riders also known as the EO 18 Riders, continue to monitor operations, provide necessary

reports and spread Road Safety Awareness by distributing Road Safety tips, Road Safety Program Laws and Ordinances Handbook to LEO's and flyers through various platforms such as the Farmers Congress Re-loaded and Social Media.

The Public Safety Office joined and facilitated the conduct of planning and actual Bambanti Festival operations as part of the committee on Traffic Management Parking and Crowd Control. Working hand in hand with various Government agencies such as the Philippine National Police, Bureau of Fire Protection and other volunteer organizations to ensure the success of said event.

The Province of Isabela has recently celebrated the Bambanti week long Festival for the year 2019 attended by thousands of visitors from all over the country.

The Office, tasked to handle the committee on Traffic Management, Parking and Crowd Control worked hand-in-hand with various Government Agencies such as the Philippine National Police, Philippine Army k-9 unit, Bureau of Fire Protection as well as other volunteer groups to ensure the safety and comfort of visitors and produc-

FIRST JOINT COMMITTEE MEETING (COMMITTEE ON TRAFFIC, PARKING AND CROWD CONTROL), IPPO PROVINCIAL DIRECTOR, BM TUGADE, PSO, PSG, ILAGAN COP

On January 10, 2019, the Public Safety Office, working as part of the Bambanti Secretariat specifically tasked to handle the committee on Traffic, Parking and Crowd Control met and had a preparatory meeting with the Isabela Police Provincial Office Provincial Director, City of Ilagan Chief of Police, Sangguinan Panlalawigan and Bambanti Director General Rolando L. Tugade and the Provincial Security Group.

The Joint Committee meeting was held at the Isabela Provincial Public Safety Office located at the rear ground floor, Isabela Provincial Capitol Building, Alibagu, City of Ilagan.

Overhead satellite images of the whole Isabela Provincial Capitol grounds and near lying areas as well as other visual aids were utilized to formalize the over-all security plan and the proposed parking areas for visitors and delegates to the said event.

Separate plans for different events were discussed for different areas as well as the arrangements for K9 unit coverage and monitoring to ensure overall visitor safety and comfort.

The half-day meeting was a preparatory consultation in anticipation of the Bambanti secretariat meeting held at the Governor's conference room on the same day which started at 1:00 pm.
