## A. Changes in the organization

As the Office takes on new tasks and responsibilities, additional manpower was needed. With the support and approval of the Provincial Administrator Atty. Noel Manuel R. Lopez and the initiative of the PSO Officer-In Kim Patrick G. -Charge Agbayani, additional manpower was added to the group (6 new hires, 1 recall) to complement the initial 10 personnel manning the Office. Due to this development, new responsibilities and designations have been adjusted and reflected in the Organizational structure of the Office.

#### B. Isabela Emergency Hotlines

The Isabela Emergency Hot-

lines is still being updated Quarterly for the benefit of all residents and visitors of the Province. Said emergency hotline summary includes hotline numbers for the local police, fire and rescue stations. This is being published and sent to all PGI Departments and Isabela stakeholders through email and social media.

## C. Safety Officer Training / Continuous Learning

The Provincial Government, in it's commitment to provide necessary learning on safety procedures and increase the PGI workforce's capacity in terms of Safety Awareness and Safety Officer roster, has successfully trained/refreshed 275 First Responders to replace transferred / inactive / retired members and conducted a refresher course. The trainings were conducted in 6 batches starting the month of September with the last batch of refresher training conducted last October. A 1 day "Two-way

Radio Communication and Radio Etiquette Crash Course" was also held for the iSMART riders.

#### C. Crafting of the Isabela Local Public Transport Route Plan

As part of the iLPTRP Technical Working Group for the Province of Isabela, with Officer-In-Charge Kim Patrick G. Agbayani at the helm as Co-Chairman of the iLPTRP Team by virtue of GRTA EO 13, series of 2023, PSO personnel, together with other partner departments/agencies PPDO, OPE, ITO, such as Enro, PNP-IPPO, DILG and partner transport cooperatives conducted a fresh set of surveys and interviews to be able to complete the Public Transport Route Plan for the Province. Using the data gathered, the writeshop was finalized for the year with the document being reviewed and prepared for initial submission to the LTFRB and the DOTr.



#### THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE

Isabela Public The Safety Office traces its humble beginnings to February 21, 2012, when Ordinance No. 001 Series of "AN ORDI-2012. entitled NANCE CREATING AND ES-**TABLISHING** THE **DEPART-**MENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY IN THE **PROVINCIAL GOVERN-**MENT OF ISABELA AND PROVIDING FUNDS THERE-FOR" authored by Sangguni-Panlalawigan Member ang Rolando L. Tugade. Chairman of the Committee on Public Security and Order, was enacted.

It was later amended by Ordinance No. 002. Series of 2014. entitled "ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE THE PROVIN-CIAL GOVERNMENT OF ISA-BELA AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREFOR", authored by Sangguniang Panlalawigan Member Hon. Karen G. Abuan, Chairman, Committee on Laws, Rules and Regulations.


#### The functions of the Office:

(a) To enforce provisions of Ordinance No. 0002-2001 otherwise known as the Provincial Administrative Code, particularly Chapter IV, Provincial Government Services: Article 1 – Peace, Order, and Security; Article 2 – Public Order; Article 3 – Safety on Public Roads; and Article 4 – Safety on Fire Hazards;

- (b) To enforce provisions of Presidential Decree No. 1566 governing the creation of Provincial Disaster Coordinating Council in the Province of Isabela now called the Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (PDRRMC) under R.A. 10121;
- (c) To enforce all other laws and ordinances relative to the protection of lives and properties, and those pertaining but not limited to the maintenance of public safety, peace and order especially during man-made or natural calamities, and the promotion of general welfare;
- (d) To ensure and provide quick response and coordinative efforts for any call or need of the public for police, fire marshals, rescue or medical assistance;
- (e) Exercise the duty to make citizen's arrest pursuant to the Rules of Court: and
- (f) Perform such other duties and functions as may be provided by law or ordinance. (Section 5, Ordinance No. 01-2014)

The Office was initially manned by Atty. Constante A. Foronda, Jr. as the Department Head, PBGEN. Jimmy U. Rivera, Sr., (Ret.) the former Provincial Director of Isabela Police Provincial Office (IPPO) as Assistant Department Head and Mr. Jose Armand G. Araneta.

Nine (9) years since its creation on January 21, 2014, Public Safety Office has evolved into what it is now. It initially shared office space with the Office of the Governor, until the District Office of then 1st District Representative Hon. Rodolfo Albano "Rodito" Τ. Ш (Incumbent Governor of Isabela) was graciously offered to be its temporary office, prior to being transferred to the former office of the Provincial Cooperatives Development Office (PCDO) at the rear ground floor of the Isabela Provincial Capitol from 2017 to 2019 before transferring to its current location at 2nd floor of the newly constructed PSO-PSWDO Building, Provincial Capitol Grounds, Alibagu, City of Ilagan, Isabela on December 2019.



## THE PSO SHIELD

The PSO Shield was designed to formally establish the identity and purpose of the Public Safety Office which was created by virtue of Sangguniang Panlalawigan Ordinance No. 002 series of 2014 on January 21, 2014.



THE SHIELD The shield signifies protection from danger, risk, or any unpleasant experience.

**Black Color of the Shield** Signifies unity and power, strength.

The Map is in green color indicating the Map of Isabela province's status as one of the top corn and rice producers of the country. It is presented with demarcation lines indicating 34 towns and 2 component cities which makes it the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest province of the Philippines. It was initially called *Isabela de Luzon* to differentiate from other places within the Country bearing the name of Isabela. The province was named after Queen Isabela II of Spain.

**The Official Seal** The Official Seal of Isabela is super imposed on top of the Malta Cross and Star of Life to signify the province's readiness to respond in all types of emergencies.

**The Maltese Cross** 

Symbolizes the good traits of a safety officer as being observant, tactful, resourceful, dexterous, explicit, discriminating, perseverant and sympathetic.

Star of Life

is a blue, six-pointed star, outlined with a white border which features the rod of Asclepius in the center. Traditionally, the logo was used as a stamp of authentication or certification for ambulances, paramedics or other EMS personnel. Internationally, it represents emergency medical services units and personnel.

The Four Connected Hands is a symbol of togetherness and participation. It signifies the unity of various units within the government working hand in hand to ensure the safety and well-being of its residents.

The People

A group of 36 persons, representing the 34 towns and 2 component cities of the Province of Isabela linking together, to provide a full and unified front against all adversities and elements that may compromise the safety and well-being of its residents.



## PUBLIC SAFETY OFFICE ACCOMPLISHMENTS FOR THE YEAR

Although the Public Safety Office responds to safety and/ or order events with the coordination with police, fire, rescue, medical, and social welfare groups, it prides itself in taking a proactive stance that focuses on providing solutions to problems before they even arise. This is done through recommendations by the Public Safety Office to the proper agencies on matters pertaining to the personal safety and security of Isabeleños in times of calamities and disasters, crime waves, terrorism and other forms of security threats.

The Office have several accomplishments in the promotion of public safety in 2023. They are the following:

- Caused the training of 7 batches (275 trained) of First Responders to replace transferred / inactive / retired members and provide continuous learning and development for our existing core of PGI Safety Officers.
- Joined and supported the Quarterly National Simultaneous Earthquake drills in full coordination with the Office of Civil Defense - Region 2, PDRRMO, BFP and other aligned agencies.



- Submit recommendations/ situational reports to the Provincial Governor regarding matters concerning Public Safety and Public Order.
- 4) Monitored and updated the Isabela Emergency Hotlines Quarterly for the benefit of all Isabela residents and visitors who might have a need for Police, Firemen and General Rescue assistance.

5) Facilitated / attended coordinating meetings and conferences with different line agencies, such as but not limited to Seal of Good Local Governance preparation and presentation and liaised with other departments with regards to Safety, Traffic, Parking, Security and Crowd Control arrangements for all PGI major events within the Provincial Capitol grounds and other areas within the Province.

- 6) Continuous production and research of IEC materials as per request and public requirement. Distributed approximately 75000++ units of various safety related flyers across the 36 LGUs within the Province.
- 7) As part of its mandate, PSO personnel joins various PGI assistance distribution activities such as Bro Scholarship Assistance Distribution, Tupad, iRISE and Tobacco Excise Tax distribution throughout the Province to ensure the safety of participants and hosts alike. In Full coordination with the Provincial Cooperative Livelihood and Development Office (PCLEDO), Public Employment Services Office (PESO), Provincial Youth and Development Office (PYDO), Bro Office, General Services Office (GSO), Provincial Security Group (PSG) and the Provincial Governor's Office (PGO) PSO personnel provide assistance in Crowd-control, Queue Management and General Public Safety and distribute Safety IEC/Flyers during the events held across the Province.
- 8) PSO personnel attended various capacity building seminars and workshops to further improve skills and knowledge on Safety such as Basic Occupational Safety and Health training conducted by the DOLE-OHSC, CSC Supervisory level trainings, Incident Command System training for Executives, Reset: Retooling Employees for Service Excellence through Technology training, Civil Service Commission Regional Office 2 free online trainings, Two-way radio communication and Radio Etiquette training, "DIFFERENT but the SAME", A customized training on Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) and Management of Multigenerational Workforce, "Office Gizmos" a Provincial Governors Office/Provincial Administrator's Office initiative among others.
- PSO personnel acted as support/ augmentation contingent during severe

weather related disturbances and assisted PDRRMO counterparts, PSWDO counterparts in their water level monitoring, rescue and relief operations as reserve pilots.

- 10) PSO intensifies Public Information and Awareness on Public Safety Guidelines and procedures through it's Social Media page <a href="https://www.facebook.com/pgipso">https://www.facebook.com/pgipso</a>, and currently maintains the PGI Safety Officer core messaging group for important updates such as Emergency Hotline Distribution, PGI important communications.
- 11) PSO personnel, as part of the Isabela Local Public Transport Route Planning Technical Working Group (iLPTRP-TWG) caused the training of surveyors and conduct of data gathering and interview/survey across the Province to be able to craft the LPTRP document/plan and be ready for submission to LTFRB and DOTr.
- 12) PSO, led by Officer-In-Charge Kim Patrick G. Agbayani was able to spearhead Gun Safety activities by hosting the License to Own and Possess Firearm (LTOPF) and Firearm Registration Caravan at GFNDy Sr. Hall, Provincial Capitol on October 31, 2023. This initiative is part of the general plan of full coordination with the Philippine National Police and other aligned agencies in promoting Gun Safety among it's constituents.
- 13) PSO personnel started managing and maintaining Employee and Public Parking areas within Provincial Capitol Grounds. 6 parking personnel are on a daily rotation schedule manning identified parking areas to assist visitors/clients and employees.
- 14) Officer-In-Charge Kim Patrick G. Agbayani was awarded as one of the Best Performing Department Heads of the year for the Provincial Government of Isabela and also received a Public Service Award from Brigada- Pahayagang Malaya's Wilfredo "Jun" Berganio.
- 15) PSO Officer-In-Charge Kim Patrick G. Agbayani and PSO III Manuel Cesar G. Binag IV participated in the Region II Public Utility Vehicle Modernization Program Stakeholder Consultation with LTFRB, DOTr, Transport groups at Tuguegarao City, Cagayan on August 11, 2023 representing the Province.

BAMBANTI 2023

Bambanti Festival has been anticipated every month of January in the Province of Isabela. This is in celebration of the Province as thanksgiving for the abundant harvest of every Isabeleño farmer and also a feast of the locals for a year full of blessings and success. This is one of the biggest festivals of the North and considered the grandest in Region 2.

For almost 10 years of celebrating Bambanti Festival, 2023 is the most challenging year for the Public Safety Office due to the volume of vehicles and hundreds to thousands of visitors coming from the hailing from as far as neighboring provinces as well as different parts of the country. With such, parking areas and crowd control has been on of the most challenging and most significant concerns categorized as top priority during the week long set of activities.

PSO Officer-In-Charge Kim Patrick G. Agbayani, as Co-Chairman of the Traffic, Parking and Crowd-Control Committee invited the different government agencies and other committee counterparts for a series of preparatory meetings and brainstorming to ensure plans are properly laid out for the said event.

Personnel from Isabela Police Provincial Office (PNP-IPPO), Isabela Provincial Risk Reduction and Management Office (PDRRMO), Barangay Alibagu Officials, Phil. Army and counterpart Army reservists, Isabela Motorcycle Action and Response Team (PNP-iSMART), Provincial Security Group (PSG Isabela), Provincial Explosive Ordnance and Canine Unit (PECU-ISABELA), Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP-ISABELA) and other volunteer groups are among the individuals/personnel who are tasked to ensure deployment and actions are according to the Committee Plans and prepared deployment assignments.



Parking preparations has been made by PSO personnel including the painting and set-up of parking paraphernalia.

During the duration of Bambanti Festival 2023, designated parking plans have been implemented in all areas within Provincial Capitol grounds and other assigned areas for the purpose. There were identified parking, established Incident

Command Post (ICP), emergency lanes and personnel deployed to assist visitors.

Day and night duty were observed for the whole duration of Bambanti Festival 2023. There are also deployment of personnel in every scheduled event to assist visitors and VIP's which adjust according to which site and schedule the major activities are held.

With additional warm bodies to supplement PSO manpower, the Bambanti Festival 2023 marks another success in the history of the Department through the able leadership of Mr. Kim Patrick G. Agbayani, his lieutenants and PSO Personnel and other counterparts.



#### PGI SAFETY OFFICER TRAINING 2023



On January 19, 2015, the Public Safety Office has established the Safety Officer System of the Provincial Capitol wherein each Department designated 4 Safety Officers; The Primary Safety Officer (SO1), Secondary Safety Officer (SO2), Tertiary Safety Officer (SO3); and Quaternary Safety Officer (SO4). Each of the Safety Officers mentioned was given a specific task and responsibilities that will be performed on a daily basis while at work and evacuation protocols to be implemented during Quarterly National Simultaneous Earthquake Drills and if a real earthquake will strike.

The Earthquake Emergency Evacuation Procedure/Protocol helps them to perform their jobs as Safety Officer during drills and natural emergencies. As part of their responsibilities, each Department's Safety Officer identifies the Primary, Secondary and Tertiary EXIT ROUTE that will be used to EXIT if there is an earthquake, fire or any calamity.

The Safety Officer System is proven to be effective as it served its purpose during actual events within the Provincial Capitol specially during the COVID-19 pandemic. Its goal is to keep all the PGI employees, clients/visitors as safe in any cases of emergency during the evacuation of the capitol.

It is deemed necessary that Safety Officers were re-certified and attended a 7-days refresher course which undergone Basic Life Support, First-Aid, Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation, Safety Officer System

Lecture, Emergency Evacuation, Fire Suppression lecture and Bomb Threat Handling. Lecturers were from the PDRRMO, PSO, BFP and Provincial Explosive Ordnance and Canine Unit (PNP -PECU).

The Public Safety Office continuously looks on ways to improve the Safety Officer System to be able to adapt to changing time and circumstances such as the most recent pandemic. From 126 Initial Safety Officers trained, it increased to 275 Safety Officers as of date, composed of PGI employees from Capitol to PGI Hospitals and National Government Agencies housed within Provincial Capitol Grounds.

This year, the PDRRMO headed by Atty. Constante A. Foronda Jr. and PSO headed by Officer-In-Charge Kim Patrick G. Agbayani together with the BFP and PNP-PECU conducted 2-day Safety Officer Basic Course activities for 7 batches to train new additions and refresh learnings for the current PGI Core of Designated Safety Officers.

The recently concluded Basic Course of Safety Officer training consists of 7 batches which started on September 19, 2023 and ended on October 11, 2023.

On September 19-20, 2023, the first batch of the PGI Safety Officer basic course was facilitated by the Provincial Public Safety Office and Provincial Disaster Risk Reduction Office, together with the Bureau of Fire Protection and PNP-PECU Provincial Explosive Ordnance and Canine Unit. There were 37

Safety Officer trained from the different PGI departments, hospitals and from the National Government Agencies. On the first day of training, the PSO welcomed the participants and discussed the Safety Officer system followed by the inspirational message of the Provincial Administrator to further educate and enhance their self confidence in performing their duties and responsibilities as Safety Officers. The BFP discussed the Fire Safety and Fire Suppression demo while the PNP-PECU discussed the Bomb Threat Management. It was noted on the first batch of training the Execution of the Duck Cover and Hold technique.

The 2 day Safety Officer Basic Course were mostly held at the GFNDy Hall from 8am-5pm with the PDRRMO Lobby and the Queen Isabela Park as alternate venue for demonstrations. The 2nd batch of Safety Officer training was held on September 21-22, 2023; batch 3 was on September 26-27, 2023; 4th batch was held on September 28-29, 2023; batch 5 training held on October 3-4, 2023; batch 6 was on October 5-6, 2023, and the last batch was on October 10-11, 2023 held at the PDRRM lobby.

As of this date, the 275 able, trained and re-certified Safety Officers are active, productive and performing.

Over the past seven years the iSMART has been the partner of PGI under the monitoring and supervision of PSO headed by Officer-In-Charge Kim Patrick Go Agbayani in the implementation of EO 18 and RA 4136 of the Land Transportation Office.
