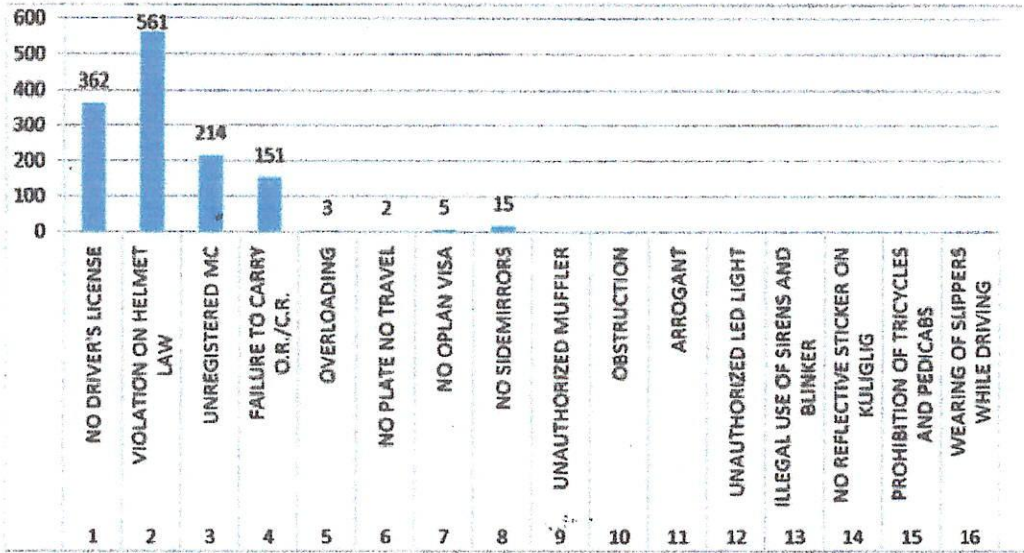

b. OPERATION:

1. Traffic Laws and Ordinance Operations

The iSMART personnel in coordination with the Land Transportation Office, Public Safety Office, and Police Provincial Office of Isabela were implementing Provincial Executive Order Number 18, OPLAN SITA, traffic laws and ordinance within the Province of Isabela covering the period from **December 1, 2023** to **December 31, 2023**. ## 2. Rescue Operation
