b. OPERATION:

1. Traffic Laws and Ordinance Operations

The iSMART personnel in coordination with the Land Transportation Office, Public Safety Office, and Police Provincial Office of Isabela were implementing Provincial Executive Order Number 18, OPLAN SITA, traffic laws and ordinance within the Province of Isabela covering the period from **April 1, 2024** to **April 30, 2024**. Stated below are the numbers of traffic violations apprehended and the estimated corresponding amount of penalty.

2. Rescue Operation

A total of **18** rescue operation were responded to by iSMART personnel together with D.A.R.T 831 Rescue team within the vicinity **of Ilagan City and Gamu Municipality** involving vehicular accident for the month of April. Victims were immediately brought to the nearest hospital for proper medication and said Incident was properly endorsed to the concerned police stations for proper disposition.
