Specifically, there is one resident each in Grades 7, 9, and 10.</li> <li>Attendance of HP Vicente during the PTCA meeting and 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter awarding and distribution of Report Cards at AES on January 10, 2025.</li> <li>Two residents were awarded with Academic Excellence (With Honors) for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of school Year 2024 – 2025.
