This includes two (2) residents in Grades 6 and two (2) in Grade 5, two (2) in Grade 4, two (2) in Grade 3, three (3) in Grade 2, and two (2) in kindergarten. At present, three (3) residents are enrolled in Alibagu National High School (ANHS). Specifically, there is one resident each in Grades 7, 9, and 10. On March 25, 2025, Psychometrician Villanueva coordinated with Ma'am Cristobal and Ma'am Nicolas, the class advisers of Grade 3 and 4 at AES, regarding incidents of bullying by certain learners against two (2) residents of Lingap. HP Atraje attended the PTCA meeting on March 24, 2025 at AES for the upcoming Baptism and First Holy Communion of two (2) Grade 5 residents. One (1) client was brought to GFNDy Memorial Hospital by PDRRMO for emergency checkup due to stomachache, accompanied by HP Atraje on March 16, 2025. On March 24, 2025, a client was brought to the same hospital for a cough, which was later found to be asthma, accompanied by HP Atraje. Close monitoring to residents who had fever, coughs, colds and toothache while regular supervision of HP on their medical intake.
