- On May 20, 2014 marked the beginning of construction of the Evacuation and Multi-Purpose Center, a provincial facility of the Provincial Government to be erected at the capitol grounds near the provincial gymnasium and Office of the Provincial Engineer. This center will serve as a temporary solace for internally displaced individuals/ families or disaster victims. The groundbreaking ceremony started at 8:30 AM which was attended by visitors from the Department of Social Welfare & Development Office (DSWD) Regional Office Field Office II, Provincial Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG), department heads and capitol employees. The ceremony was highlighted by the message of the Provincial Governor, Honourable Faustino G. Dy III expressing his concerns for response & recovery of every victim of a catastrophe. Welcoming the visitors and overview of the said center was presented by PSWDO Ms. Lucila Ambatali. Messages were also delivered by the DSWD FO2 Head of Disaster Management, Mr. Frank Lopez and Provincial DILG Director, Mr. Elpidio Durwin. The blessing of the site was solemnized by Reverend Father Alden Zulueta and was followed by the groundbreaking ceremony
