D. PERSONNEL STAFFING

As of April 2025, there are one hundred five (105) plantilla positions, of which seventy-eight (78) personnel hold permanent positions. Currently, there are 6 permanent Physicians, 2 contractual Physicians, 1 permanent Radiologist, 12 Private Doctors, and 3 Doctors from the Department of Health (DOH) with different specialties serving the hospital under a Memorandum of Agreement with the Provincial Government of Isabela.

In the nursing service, there are 27 permanent Nurses, 17 contractual Nurses, 8 permanent Nursing Attendants, 9 contractual Nursing Attendants, and 1 permanent Midwife.

In the ancillary services, there is 1 permanent Dentist, 1 contractual Dental Aide, 3 permanent Medical Technologists, 8 contractual Medical Technologists, 1 permanent Laboratory Aide, 1 permanent Radiologic Technologist, 2 permanent Medical Equipment Technologists, 4 contractual Radiologic Technologists, 2 permanent Pharmacists, 4 contractual Pharmacists, 2 contractual Pharmacy Aide and 1 contractual Dialysis Technician.

In administrative services, there are 25 permanent employees and 35 contractual employees.


