RESOLUTION NO. 360

A RESOLUTION EARNESTLY URGING ALL GOVERNMENT OFFICES, BUSINESS SECTORS, AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC TO SUPPORT THE ANTI-DENGUE CAMPAIGN OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH

WHEREAS, on July 16, 2019, the World Health Organization released "Situation Report 1: Dengue Outbreak" finding that dengue cases in the Philippines from January 1, 2019 to June 29, 2019 has drastically increased compared to 2018;

WHEREAS, in line with this finding and the worsening public situation at hand, the Department of Health declared a National Dengue Alert on July 15, 2019 urging for the intensification of dengue surveillance, case management and outbreak response and other activities necessary for the reduction, prevention, and suppression of dengue incidences in the country;

WHEREAS, based on a report from the Philippine Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response System, dengue cases in Region II significantly rose, from 1,742 with 7 recorded deaths in January 1 to June 29, 2018, to 6,499 with 24 recorded deaths of the same time span for this year;

WHEREAS, this Body expressed concern over such alarming statistics considering that the Province is yet to experience the rainy season, when dengue cases become more prevalent;

WHEREAS, this Body finds it extremely necessary to provide the Department of Health the necessary backing and assistance in its campaign against dengue, especially as dengue, when left unchecked, poses considerable threat to the general welfare and health of Isabeleños;


