WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 7160, or the Local Government Code of 1991, duly empowers local government units to exercise the necessary, appropriate, or incidental powers to promote the general welfare of its people, including, among others, the enhancement of economic prosperity and the promotion of full employment within their respective territories;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Isabela upholds a policy in which it accords preferential consideration to the welfare of the farmers and the development of the agriculture sector in the formulation of its policies and in the implementation of its programs;

WHEREAS, the Provincial Government of Isabela recognizes cooperatives and other non-government organizations as key partners in the attainment of genuine, lasting, and inclusive progress of its people;

WHEREAS, in line with such a policy, the Provincial Government of Isabela formulated and implemented the Isabela Recovery Initiatives to Support Enterprises (I-RISE) Program to improve the productivity, profitability, and viability of cooperatives and other similar non-government associations and organizations;

WHEREAS, for Calendar Year (CY) 2023, the Provincial Government of Isabela implements the I-RISE Program which provides assistance to the beneficiaries such as product procurement at premium prices, and assistance in the production, processing, and promotion of their products, with a focus on distribution of such products to vulnerable individuals to maximize the number of beneficiaries deriving benefits from this program;

WHEREAS, the Rang-Ayan Nature Spring Farmers Multipurpose Cooperative, a duly existing institution duly registered with the Cooperative Development Authority engaged in the production of forest tree seedlings, is a beneficiary of the I-RISE Program for CY 2023;

WHEREAS, as a beneficiary of I-RISE Program, the Provincial Government of Isabela will extend assistance to Rang-Ayan Nature Spring Farmers Multipurpose Cooperative by purchasing Three Thousand Five Hundred (3,500) Narra Seedlings, Five Thousand (5,000) Mahogany Seedlings, Three Thousand Five Hundred (3,500) Tindalo Seedlings, Three Thousand Five Hundred (3,500) Bayog Seedlings, And Three Thousand Five Hundred (3,500) Kiling Seedlings amounting to Five Hundred Eleven Thousand Pesos (Php 511,000.00);

WHEREAS, submitted for the review and approval of this August Body is a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) to be entered into by and between the Provincial Government of Isabela and Rang-Ayan Nature Spring Farmers Multipurpose Cooperative for the undertaking discussed in the previous whereas clause;

WHEREAS, Section 465(b)(1)(vi) of R. A. No. 7160 empowers the Provincial Governor to represent the Province in all its transactions and sign on its behalf all contracts and such other documents upon the issuance of an authority by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan;

WHEREAS, after careful review, this August Body determined the provisions of the said MOA to be just, lawful, and provides all appropriate measures to ensure compliance with pertinent laws on government procurement, and that authorizing the Honorable Governor to sign such MOA on behalf of the Provincial Government of Isabela promotes the welfare and serves the interest of the Isabeleños;

**WHEREFORE**, upon motion of the Honorable Edward S. Isidro, duly approved and seconded in a session duly assembled, it was –
